5 NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS



- Computers, iPads, art materials and science equipment
- *Amidon-Bowen Elementary School, Brent Elementary, Jefferson Middle School, Payne Elementary School, Van Ness Elementary School*

3 HEALTH AND WELLNESS INITIATIVES



- Physical fitness and soccer program at local schools, open-air market with locally grown produce, and fitness equipment for a local community center
- *Capitol Quarter Community Center, DC Scores, Fresh Farm*

3 ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS



- Friday Night Fishing, the “Floating Library” program, and recycling receptacles throughout the neighborhood
- *Anacostia Riverkeeper, Earth Conservation Corps, Living Classrooms*



4 YOUTH & ADULT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

- A breakfast program for at-risk community members, after-school and summer camp programs, art and music lessons, a journalism and media program, tutoring/mentoring services and college preparatory help

As part of the Virginia Avenue Tunnel project, CSX is providing a \$650,000 Supplemental Community Mitigation Fund to offset temporary inconveniences resulting from the project and to support neighborhood enhancements. To date, the fund has provided support for more than 20 local organizations, including schools, nonprofits, environmental advocacy groups, community groups and churches. Community members have a direct say in how the funds are used to better their neighborhood.
